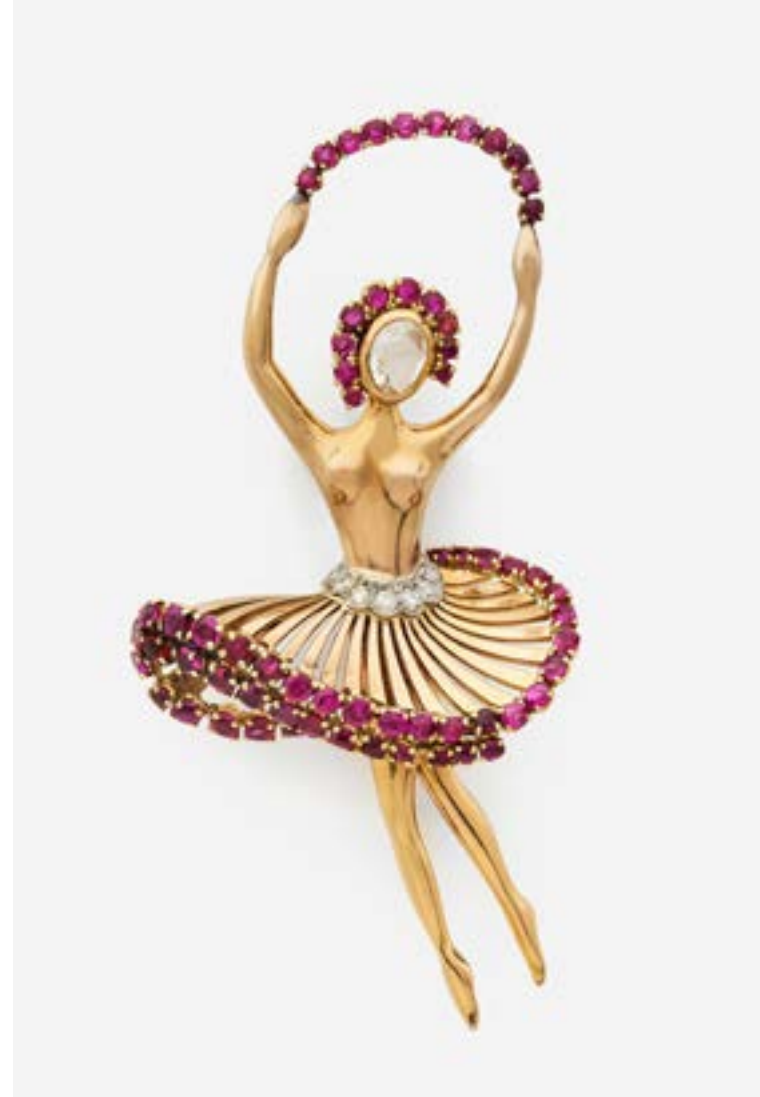

THE ARTCURIAL GROUP

*European leader, with
1,75 billion in sales in 2025*

The Artcurial Group, one of Europe's leading intermediaries in the sale of exceptional assets, comprises three major complementary entities: Artcurial, an auction house; John Taylor, a specialist in luxury real estate; and Arqana, Europe's leading auction house for racehorses.

John Taylor strengthened its position as a market leader in a particularly demanding environment, delivering solid results and controlled growth compared to 2024. The year was marked by the opening of four new offices in Marseille, Cyprus, Nyon, and Saint-Barthelemy, as well as a strategic relocation in Geneva.

The Group also officially opened its physical office in Marrakech within the luxury hotel La Mamounia, a prestigious location that further enhances the synergies developed with Artcurial. Already established in Dubai, John Taylor continues its expansion in the Middle East, with planned openings in Abu Dhabi, Saudi Arabia, and Qatar.

Arqana organized 13 physical auctions and 10 online sales this year, presenting 4,043 horses, 78 % of which were sold. These sales generated a record total auction volume of €216,097,500.

The year 2025 was marked by an exceptional edition of the August Sale, with eight horses sold for over €1 million and a historic top price of €3 million for a filly presented in Deauville. The May Breeze Up also confirmed its position as a European benchmark, with four horses sold above €1 million and a record average price exceeding €200,000, bringing the annual average price across all sales to €66,240.
